- WI Dairy Rules Advisory Committee Update
 - Proposal to the state to allow for full-load pickups to be picked up on-farm and scaled at the plant with the scale weight recorded at the farm the next day (could also take a sample at the plant if there is agitation to allow for faster pickup time)
 - Example of issues: Trouble at Robot farms – by the time the hauler gets in to get the milk settled down it takes 10-20 min and then agitation takes even longer, pump time can be 35-45 min. Before long, with cleaning it can be 1.5 hours or longer
 - This is not just for robot farms, but for any full-load farm.
 - Need to have this pass the state regulatory committee.
- Election
 - Vote on current officers holding office positions for one year, or elect a new board member
 - With the limited activity of the association for the past year, the current board members are willing to repeat their positions for one more year.
 - If the proposal for the board members to hold positions for one more year is defeated, the Second Vice President position will need to be filled.
